2010 Pack 29 Pinewood Derby Volunteer Task Details

Setup - The track (and other race materials) are stored in the basement of the church. Setting starts with retrieving the track, etc. and bringing it to the Epworth Center via pickup truck. Next, the track will be assembled. Also, check-in tables, chairs, projector, etc. will be setup.

Check-In - Two volunteers are requested here at a time in order to check-in cars. Each car must be examined to ensure it meets the specifications. Each car will also be assigned a number. Volunteers should not check-in cars for their son's race.

Launcher - The launcher will place cars on the track and release them for the race.

Retriever - The retriever will retrieve cars from the end of the track and bring them back to the beginning. They also ensure that the race has a good finish (that the places are correctly calculated by the electronic eye).

Runner - The runner will take cars from the check-in table and bring them to the launcher based on each heat. The runner will also confirm the placements for the scorekeeper.

Design Vote Coordinator – The design vote coordinator will coordinate getting the ballots from the scouts for their design award voting. The coordinator will also tally votes and resolve any ties by use of 3 impartial judges.

Announcer - The announcer will announce each car for each heat and announce the winners. Creativity is always welcome!!

Official Scorer - The official scorer keeps track of placements and determines how each car is placed in each heat. This is all done via a spreadsheet and is displayed on a projector for spectators to enjoy.

Award Presenter - This person presents awards after each rank's race and the championship race.

Cleanup - Cleanup is basically the opposite of setup. The more volunteers, the easier.

Race Official - The race official is in charge of the race. Any disputes are settled by the race official and the decision of the race official is final. The race official will supervise and help out if needed in conducting the race.
